- Age and all other qualification will be counted as on the last date of submission of application.
- As per Ministry of Human Resource Development Notification dated- 10.06.2015 published in Gazette of India all the degrees/diplomas/certificates including technical education degrees/diplomas awarded through Open and Distance Learning Mode of education by the Universities established by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature, Institutions Deemed to be Universities under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and Institutions of National Importance declared under an Act of Parliament stand automatically recognized for the purpose of employment to posts and services under the Central Government provided they have been approved by the University Grants Commission.



GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The posts carry usual allowances as admissible to Central Government Employees of similar status stationed at Patna.
2. The aspiring applicants satisfying the eligibility criteria in all respect can submit their application only through **ON-LINE** mode. The On-line registration of application is made available on AIIMS, Patna official website i.e. <http://www.aiimspatna.org>. The link for submission of online applications in respect of above said posts along-with other relevant information is available on the website. **The last date of online submission of applications will be on 30th day from the date of publication in Employment News/ Rojgar Samachar.** No Documents including online application form is required to be sent, however, all the applicants are advised to keep a copy of online application form with them, along with proof of payment (online payment receipt) for their record.
3. The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must be fulfilling eligibility criteria as on the closing date of applications failing which their application will be rejected.
4. **The On-line application will be closed on the 30th day from the date of publication in Employment News/Rojgar Samachar.** The candidature of such applicants who fails to complete the online application submission by the stipulated date and time will not be considered and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
5. **The Candidate must ensure that their recent Photo with Name, selected Government approved Photo ID which you will bring to enter Examination Venue and Signature should be clearly visible in preview at the time of filling of application in online mode.** If photo/signature image is displayed small or not visible in preview on website, that means photo/signature is not as per AIIMS, Patna prescribed and in that case, the application will be rejected. The candidates are requested to be careful while uploading photo and signature. Both must be visible clearly on Online Application form.
6. **APPLICATION FEES:**
 - a For **Women Candidates:-** Rs. 1200/-*
 - * This fee of Rs. 1200/- shall be refunded duly deducting Bank Charges as applicable, if the candidate appears in the Written Examination.
 - b For **All other categories (GEN/OBC) :-** Rs. 1500/-
 - c **PwBD Candidates:** Exempted
 - d The candidate will be required to pay prescribed application fees through **Online Mode Only via payment gateway of AIIMS, Patna.** Transaction/ Processing fee, if any, as applicable will be payable to the bank by the candidate.
 - e **Application Fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances except the case mentioned in point 1 above.**
 - f Applications without the prescribed fee would not be considered and summarily rejected.



7. **AGE RELAXATION:-**

- 1) Upper age limit shall be determined as on last date of receipt of applications.
- 2) Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation/ Secondary Examination Certificate only will be accepted by AIIMS, Patna for determining the age, and no subsequent request for change will be considered or granted.
- 3) **No Age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying for unreserved vacancies.**
- 4) Permissible relaxation of upper age limit as per Government orders (as on the last date of receipt of application) are as under:-

NOTE-I: Ex-servicemen who have already secured employment in civil side under Central Government on regular basis after availing of the benefits of reservation given to ex-servicemen for their re-employment are **NOT** eligible for fee concession or for claiming benefits of reservation under Ex-Serviceman category. However, they are eligible for age relaxation as per rules.



NOTE-II: The period of "Call up Service" of an Ex-Serviceman in the Armed Forces shall also be treated as service rendered in the Armed Forces for purpose of age relaxation, as per rules.

NOTE-III: For any serviceman of the three Armed Forces of the Union to be treated as Ex-Serviceman for the purpose of securing the benefits of reservation, he must have already acquired, at the relevant time of submitting his application for the Post / Service, the status of ex-serviceman and /or is in a position to establish his acquired entitlement by documentary evidence from the competent authority that he would complete specified term of engagement from the Armed Forces within the stipulated period of one year from the CLOSING DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATION or otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency.

EXPLANATION: An 'ex-serviceman' means a person –

- (i) Who 'has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the India Union, and
 - (a) who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension; **or**
 - (b) who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; **or**
 - (c) who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment; **or**
- (ii) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service; **or**
- (iii) Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstance beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension; **or**
- (iv) Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1988; **or**
- (v) Gallantry award winners of the Armed forces including personnel of Territorial Army; **or**
- (vi) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.

NOTE-IV: AGE CONCESSION IS NOT ADMISSIBLE TO SONS, DAUGHTERS AND DEPENDENTS OF EX-SERVICEMEN.

8. i) Candidates who wish to be considered against vacancies reserved/or seek age-relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the competent authority, in the prescribed format when such certificates are sought by the Institute. Otherwise, their claim for SC/ST/OBC/PwD/EXs status will not be entertained and their candidature/ applications will be considered under General (UR) category.



- ii) A person seeking appointment on the basis of reservation to OBCs must ensure that he/ she possesses the caste/ community certificate and does not fall in creamy layer on the crucial date i.e. as on last date of submission of online application. OBC candidate's eligibility will be based on Castes borne in the Central List of Govt. of India. OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer. Their Sub-caste should match with the entries in Central List of OBC, failing which their candidature will not be considered under any of the applied reserved category and will be treated as UR.
- iii) Candidates may also note that in respect of the above, their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified by AIIMS, Patna. **Candidates are warned that they will be permanently debarred from the examinations conducted by AIIMS, Patna in case they fraudulently claim SC/ST/OBC/ExS/PwD/EWS status apart from initiating criminal action against them.**
- iv) Only such persons would be eligible for reservation under PwD quota in service/posts who suffer from not less than 40% of disability as identified for that post as per Govt. of India instructions. Person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation would have to submit a Disability Certificate issued by a Competent Authority as notified by the Government in prescribed format.

9. **IMPORTANT NOTE FOR EWS (ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS):**

- 1) 10% reservation would be provided for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in central government posts and services, as per the directions of Government of India instructions issued vide DoPT OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 19th January, 2019.
- 2) Persons who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations to the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh are to be identified as EWSs for the benefit of reservation. Family for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years. The income shall include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. and it will be income for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWSs, irrespective of the family income:
 - i. 5 acres of Agricultural Land and above;
 - ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
 - iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
 - iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.
- 3) The income and assets of the families as mentioned in para 2 would be required to be certified by an officer not below the rank of Tehsildar in the States/UTs. The candidates shortlisted for document verification/interview shall be required to bring the requisite certificate as specified by the Government of India at the time of appearing for the process of document verification/interview.
- 4) The instructions issued by the Government of India in this regard from time to time shall be adhered to.
- 5) The vacancies advertised under EWS Category are as per the instructions issued by DoPT, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension, Govt. of India, vide OM. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019. Application under EWS category will be



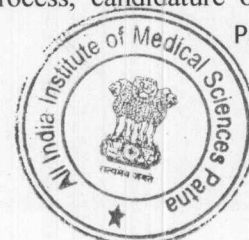
considered subject to submission of Income & Assets Certificate on a prescribe format issued by the Competent Authority and subject to verification of genuinity of the certificate by issuing authority. As per DoP&T OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019, the crucial date for submitting income and asset certificate by the candidate is the closing date for receipt of application for the post, except in cases where date is fixed otherwise. Therefore, a valid EWS certificate will be the one which has been issued by the competent authority, as prescribed by the GOI/DOPT. EWS Certificate issued during the period from **01.04.2021 to 31.03.2022** will be considered valid. Candidates who fail to produce valid EWS Certificate will not be considered for reservation under this Category. They will however, be considered for UR category. Format of EWS Certificate is attached at **APPENDIX-V.**

10. **IMPORTANT NOTE FOR PERSON WITH DISABILITIES (PwBD) CATEGORY:**

- All PWBD candidates with disabilities mentioned in Section 32 (1) of Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016, are eligible to apply under this category provided they have benchmark disability of equal to or more than 40%.
- After any candidate qualifies the written examination, such candidates will be subjected to medical examination by a board constituted by AIIMS to ascertain their suitability for the job.
*As per DOPT office memorandum No. No.36035/02/2017-Estt (Res) dated 15.01.2018 same relaxed standard should be applied for all the candidates with Benchmark Disabilities whether they belong to Unreserved/SC/ST/OBC. No further relaxation of standards will be considered or admissible in favour of any candidate from any category whatsoever.

11. **Provision of Compensatory Time and assistance of scribe:**

- (i) The facility of scribe/reader/lab assistant shall be applicable in case of persons with disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arm affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, if so desired by the person. In case of other category of persons with disabilities, the provision of scribe/reader/lab assistant can be provided if he/she has intimated in writing including that of speed. However it will only be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution as per proforma at **APPENDIX-I.**
- (ii) Such candidates, who are allowed use of scribe are also allowed for compensatory time of 20 minutes (or otherwise advised) for every hour of the examination.
- (iii) The candidate will have to arrange his/ her own scribe at his/her own cost.
- (iv) The qualification of the scribe should be one level below the educational eligibility of the post.
- (v) Both the candidate as well as scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking confirming that the scribe fulfils all the stipulated eligibility criteria for a scribe. Further in case it later transpires that he/she did not fulfil any laid down eligibility criteria or suppressed material facts the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result of the examination.
- (vi) A person acting as scribe for one candidate cannot be a scribe for another candidate.
- (vii) The scribe arranged by candidate should not be candidate for the online examination. If violation of the above is detected at any stage of the process, candidature of both the



candidate and the scribe will be cancelled. Candidates eligible for and who wish to use the services of a scribe in the examination should invariably carefully indicate the same in the online application form. Any subsequent request may not be favourably entertained.

- (viii) The scribe should not be a candidate for this process. In case it is found at any stage, that the scribe has also appeared for the same exam in a different session, the candidature of both the scribe and the candidate will be cancelled.
- (ix) Only candidates registered for compensatory time will be allowed such concessions since compensatory time given to candidates shall be system based. It will not be possible for the test conducting agency to allow such time if he / she is not registered for the same. Candidates not registered for compensatory time will not be allowed such concessions.
- (x) Name of the Scribe along with his certificate regarding educational qualification will have to be submitted. Educational Qualification of the Scribe has to be one step below the educational eligibility of the post.

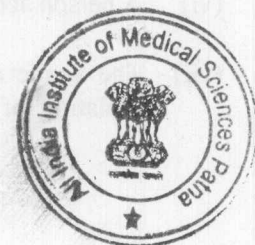

INDICATIVE SYLLABUS FOR EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF JUNIOR ENGINEER (AC&R)

- (a) **General Intelligence & Reasoning:** It would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, spatial orientation, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, coding and decoding, statement conclusion, syllogistic reasoning etc. The topics are, Semantic Analogy, Symbolic/Number Analogy, Figural Analogy, Semantic Classification, Symbolic/Number Classification, Figural Classification, Semantic Series, Number Series, Figural Series, Problem Solving, Word Building, Coding & decoding, Numerical Operations, symbolic Operations, Trends, Space Orientation, Space Visualization, Venn Diagrams, Drawing inferences, Punched hole/pattern –folding & unfolding, Figural Pattern – folding and completion, Indexing, Address matching, Date & city matching, Classification of centre codes/roll numbers, Small & Capital letters/numbers coding, decoding and classification, Embedded Figures, Critical thinking, Emotional Intelligence, Social Intelligence, Other sub-topics, if any.



(b) **General Awareness:** Questions in this component will be aimed at testing the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Policy & Scientific Research.

(c) **Subject knowledge:**

General - Knowledge of Indian Electricity Act, Indian Elect. Rules as amended up-to-date. General conditions of supply and charges to be paid to licencees for obtaining connection. CPWD General Specifications for Electrical Works, Principles of analysis of rates. General Principles in preparation of estimates, project reports, award of works and execution of works and measurement. ISI/BIS Standards and Codes of practices.

Internal Electrical Installations -

Systems of wiring and their design, distribution system. Apparatus for control, protection and Testing.

Earthing, Lighting Protection, Safety & Maintenance -

Necessity of earthing, earthing resistance, type of earthing. Lighting protection design, layout, material and installation. Safety procedures and practices, principles of equipment installation, preventive maintenance and testing of equipment.

Sub-Station up to 33 KV and Distribution -

Layout and Design for indoor and outdoor application. Specifications for equipment, Sub-Station earthlings, stand-by generating sets, commissioning procedures and tests. Distribution: Design of overhead line and underground distribution systems. Specification for cables, conductors, Supports etc. Cable joining and termination methods, power factor improvement, service connection to buildings.

Air-Conditioning Ventilation -

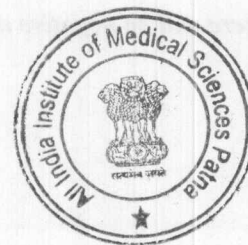
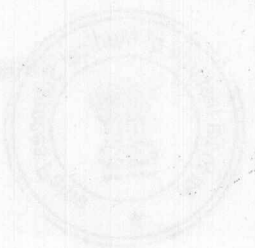
General principles of Refrigeration, AirConditioning, evaporative cooling and ventilation, Heating and cooling load estimation. Classification of systems, their design and application, structural requirements, specifications for installations.

Water Supply -

Types of pumps and their characteristics. Prime movers, pumping systems and application. Specification for equipment and installation.

ELECTRICAL APPARATUS-

- (i) Single and poly phase A.C. Circuit. Effects of resistance inductance and capacitance.
- (ii) Single and poly phase transformers— constructional features, equivalent circuits performance, parallel operation, phase conversion. Separation of losses and determination of efficiency by various methods. Auto transformers.
- (iii) Alternators, Constructional features, regulation, parallel operation and Protection. Automatic Voltage regulators, Emergency generating sets, automatic change over.



- (iv) Induction machines, polyphasemotor and its principle of operation and equivalent circuit. Torque, slip characteristics. Crawling, methods of starting, single phase motor, its theory, characteristics and application.

INSTRUMENT TRANSFORMERS, PROTECTIVE RELAYING, MEASUREMENTS -

Current, Voltage transformers. Constructional features of IDMT relays, instantaneous relays including knowledge of overload earth fault, undervoltage, Bucholz relays. Connection diagrams, settings. Electrical instruments and Measurements, principles of construction and theory of measuring instruments for direct and alternating currents. Commercial types. Measurement of resistance, Voltage, current, power, power factor and energy. Watt meters, energy meters. Thermocouples, Resistance Thermometers, Pyro-meters. Fault locating bridges for cables. Measurements of resistance, inductance and capacitance, Wheatstone bridge.

INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES

Fuels and Combustion. Fuels and their properties, combustion calculations. Analysis of products of combustion. Power cycles. Vapor power cycles Carnot and Rankine. Gas Power- Otto and Diesel cycles. Deviation of actual cycles from theoretical cycles. Internal combustion engines – Two and four stroke compression ignition and spark ignition engines. Combustion phenomena. Detonation, Knocking, scavenging of two stroke engines. Fuel injection and carburation. Lubrication and cooling system performance and testing of IC engines. Pollution control requirements/standards.

HEATING, AIR CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION

Refrigeration – Refrigeration and heat pump cycles. Vapour compression, absorption Cycles. Refrigerants and their characteristics. Air Conditioning – Psychrometric chart, comfort air-conditioning, comfort indices, ventilation requirements. Cooling and dehumidification methods. Industrial air-conditioning processes. Different methods of electric heating. Construction and performance of Electric heating equipment.

WORKSHOP TECHNOLOGY

Estimation of power and energy requirements of electric welding, different types of equipments used and their characteristics. Manufacturing and Fabricating methods and practices for various electrical and mechanical equipment such as pumps, switch boards, light fittings, AHUs etc.

ENERGY CONSERVATION, POWER FACTOR IMPROVEMENT

Comparison of different types of lamps from the point of energy conservation, calculation of payback period. Power factor improvement, Reduction of load current and transformer losses due to power factor improvements. KVA requirement for power factor improvement.

SOLAR ENERGY UTILISATION

Solar Hot Water system, principles, constructional features, constituent parts, installation, operation & maintenance, solar photo voltaic system, advantages/disadvantages of solar heating & solar photo voltaic system.

**Compensatory time of 1 hour will be provided to PwBD candidates, who are eligible for the same as mentioned in Para- 10 above.*

Questions will be Objective Type Multiple Choice, Set in both Hindi and English in respect of Parts A, B & C.

There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.



Note – I: The Institute reserves the right to conduct the examination through Computer based online/ offline mode. The Institute also reserves the right to introduce additional stage of examination which would be notified at suitable time if considered necessary.

Note– II: Any representation to key of the examination will be scrutinized with the help of experts, wherever necessary, and evaluation in that case will be done with modified answer key. Candidates are advised to download their Admit Card from AIIMS website www.aiimspatna.org as no admit card will be sent by post.

15. The candidates are advised to bring Admit Card downloaded from AIIMS website at the time of Online (CBT) mode Examination and hand over the same to the Invigilator after completing the Examination, failing which their candidature/performance in the Online (CBT) mode Examination will not be considered.

16. **Document Verification:**

The original certificates/documents of successful candidates will be verified for which dates will be notified. On the basis of written test, the provisionally qualified candidates will be required to produce following original certificates/ documents along with one set of photocopy, duly self-attested viz.:

- xi) Identity Proof (PAN Card, Passport, Driving License, Voter Card, Aadhar Card and Government Approved Identity Proof)
- xii) Address Proof (Aadhar Card, Passport, Ration Card, Driving License and Government Approved Address Proof.
- xiii) Any other relevant documents.



17. **Mode of Selection:**

- i) SC, ST, OBC, Ex-Servicemen, PwD and EWS candidates, who are selected on their own merit without relaxed standards, along with candidates belonging to other communities, will not be adjusted against the reserved share of vacancies. Such candidates will be accommodated against the general/unreserved vacancies in the post as per their position in the overall Merit List or vacancies earmarked for their category, whichever is advantageous to them. The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible SC, ST, OBC, Ex-Servicemen, PwD and EWS candidates who are lower in merit than the last general candidate on merit list of unreserved category but otherwise found suitable for appointment by relaxed standard.
- ii) SC, ST, OBC, Ex-Servicemen, PwD and EWS category candidates who qualifies on the basis of relaxed standards viz. age limit, experience or qualifications, permitted number of chances in written examination, extended zone of consideration, etc. is to be counted against reserved vacancies and not against general vacancies subject to fitness of such candidate for selection. Such candidates may also be recommended at the relaxed standards to the extent the number of vacancies reserved for them, to make up for the deficiency in the reserved quota, irrespective of their rank in the order of merit. In so far as cases of Ex-Servicemen are concerned, deduction from the age of Ex-Servicemen is permissible against the reserved or unreserved posts and such exemption cannot be termed as relaxed standards in regard to age. Similarly, for PwD candidates, relaxation of 10 years in upper age limit will not be termed as relaxed standards.
- iii) A person with disability who qualifies the AIIMS, Patna examination under General standards can be appointed against unreserved vacancy provided the post is identified suitable for person with disability of relevant category.
- iv) Success in the examination confers no right of appointment unless AIIMS, Patna is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects of appointment to the service/post.
- v) The candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions for post applied for. Their admission at all stages of the examination will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If, on verification, at any time before or after the written examination, it is found that they do not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the examination and selection thereafter, if done will be cancelled by the AIIMS, Patna.
- vi) The minimum qualifying marks for recruitment examination will be 50% for UR, 45% for OBC, 40% for SC/ST.
- vii) In case two candidates get equal marks which will be considered for selection, the candidate who is older in age will be given preference.
- viii) No wait-list will be published further.

18. **Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct:**

Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information while filling in the application form. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case attempt to alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or the attested certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document.



Without prejudice to criminal action/debarment from AIIMS Patna examination wherever necessary, candidature will be summarily cancelled at any stage of the recruitment in respect of candidates found to have indulged in any of the following:

- i) In possession of mobile phone & accessories and other electronic gadgets within the premises of the examination centres, whether in use or in switched off mode and on person or otherwise.
- ii) Involved in malpractices.
- iii) Using unfair means in the examination hall.
- iv) Obtaining support for his/her candidature by any means.
- v) Impersonate/Procuring impersonation by any person.
- vi) Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with.

- xiii) Candidature can also be cancelled at any stage of the recruitment for any other ground which the AIIMS Patna considers to be sufficient cause for cancellation of candidature.

19. **AIIMS, Patna Decision Final:**

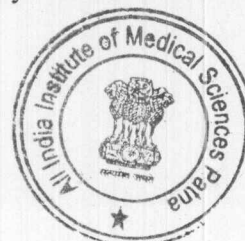
The decision of the AIIMS, Patna in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), allotment of examination centres and selection will be final and binding on the candidates. No enquiry/correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

20. Joining on Technical Resignation from their previous posting at AIIMS, Patna will not be done/allowed.

21. Those who are in employment (in Case Govt. Services) must submit a **“NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE”** from the employer at the time of Document Verification and should have to produce Relieving Certificate from their present employer at the time of joining the Institute. No extension of joining time of candidate will be granted under any circumstances.


