1. Introduction

All India Institute of Medical Sciences Patna (AIIMS Patna) is an institution of national importance. It was established in 2012 with the objective to develop a medical workforce to demonstrate a high standard of Medical Education and sophisticated health care. AIIMS Patna has started different 2 years Post-doctoral Fellowship (PDF) courses in Critical Care Medicine, Neuro-anaesthesiology, Paediatric anaesthesiology, Paediatric Critical Care, Neuro and Vascular Interventional Radiology, Neurotology and skull base Surgery, Lower Limb arthroplasty and Neonatal Surgery.

The entrance test for admission to this Course will be conducted by AIIMS Patna and will be held once a year in the month of July. Kindly refer to the Important Dates Tab for a detailed schedule.

This Prospectus of PDF Course (AIIMS Patna) for the year 2023 consists of information regarding eligibility criteria for appearing in the examination, examination centre, application fee, the process of application, scheme of examination/evaluation, admission fee, salary/stipend, rules of leaves, hostel accommodation, penalty after resignation, Exit examination etc. for the purpose of the conduct of common entrance test. The candidates are advised to regularly visit the website www.aiimspatna.edu.in for recent updates. The result will be published through website notification. All disputes with regard to any matter referred to herein shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of Patna Courts only.

2. Aims and Objectives

The AllMS Patna was established with the objective to provide a high standard of medical education and teaching for undergraduate and post-graduate, and to improve professional competence among medical practitioners, to attain self-sufficiency in postgraduate medical education and promoting medical research in the field of postgraduate and post-doctoral education. Along with this most important function of the Institute is to provide opportunities to train teachers for medical colleges in the country in an atmosphere of research and development. Fellowship Programme students are initiated not only to expose to newer methods of teaching and training but it also provides opportunities to actively participate in research and learning exercises. The other important objectives of the Institute are to bring together in one place educational facilities of the highest order for the training of personnel in all the important branches of health activity and to attain self-sufficiency in medical education. The educational principles and practices being adopted are best suited to the needs of the nation.

5. Other terms and conditions

- 1. No reservation is applicable in DM/M.Ch./ PDF Courses as per Judgment of the Constitution Bench of Supreme Court of India Writ Petition No. 350/1998.
- 2. The candidates must have completed the requisite qualification, degree, and tenure by 31.08.2023. The candidates who are likely to complete their 3 years of requisite qualification, degree, and tenure after 31.08.2023 will not be eligible for joining this Post-doctoral Fellowship Course.
- 3. Those candidates who are in Government service must produce a No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued by the competent authority at the time of counselling.
- 4. The courses will start from dates as mentioned in *important dates at a glance*.
- 5. The last date for admission to the PDF course will be as per dates mentioned in *important dates at a glance*. In any circumstances, the last date for admission will not be extended after the dates mentioned above. This includes candidates on the wait list who may be offered a seat if the selected candidates do not join.

9. Declaration of Result

10. Merit List

All qualified candidates will be assigned a rank and will be placed in the list in order of overall rank. The merit list will be prepared as per the percentile scores. The candidate must secure a 50th percentile mark to be eligible for admission.

11. Method of Resolving Ties

- i. According to Age (Date of Birth), the older candidate shall get preference over the younger one.
- ii. If the age is the same, then the candidate who has scored a less negative score will rank senior
- iii. If the negative score is also the same, then a candidate who has obtained higher marks (Aggregate) in the MD/MS/MCh exam will rank senior.
- iv. If marks in MD/MS/MCh are also equal or if marks are not allotted, then a candidate who has obtained higher marks (Aggregate) in MBBS will rank as senior.

12. Joining

The first counselling for admission will take place on 10.08.2023. The selected candidate is required to join the course on or before 16.08.2023. In case the selected candidate fails to join or intimate through surface email till 16.08.2023 it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join the course and the seat will be offered to the next candidate in the order of merit list

The last date for admission to the course will be 31.08.2023. In any circumstances, the last date for admission will not be extended beyond 31.08.2023.

24. Submission of caste certificate by SC/ST/OBC/EWS Candidates:

Although, no reservation is applicable in DM/M.Ch./PDF courses, however, candidates seeking relaxation in age/ application fee on the basis of caste, have to submit an attested copy of the scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribe, or Other Backward Classes (NCL) or EWS, as applicable, along with other requisite documents, from any of the following authorities stating that the candidate belongs to the Scheduled caste, scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy layer certificate in the central government format within one year of last date of submission of online application), or EWS in the prescribed format at the time of counseling/Document verification.

- A. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Collector, Deputy Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Deputy Collector, 1st class Stipendiary Magistrate, City Magistrate, Sub-divisional Magistrate, Taluka Magistrate, Executive Magistrate, Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- B. Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
- C. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- D. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and his or her family normally reside.
- E. Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/ Development Officer (Lakshadweep Island) or as authorized in the Constitution.

The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of their caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail the cancellation of registration. This is as per the provisions made by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances, and Pensions vide their order No. 36033/4/97-Estt. (RES) Dated 25-07-2003 and No.36011/3/2005-Estt. (RES) dated 9.9.2005 respectively.

Candidates must note that a certificate from any other person/authority will not be accepted and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. The name, designation, and seal of the officer should be legible on the certificate.

25. Reasons for Rejection/ Cancellation of sApplication/Candidature:

Application/Candidature of Applicants is liable to be Cancelled/ Rejected Summarily at any stage of the Admission Process in the event of all or any of the following:

- i. Applications are incomplete.
- ii. Any variation in the signatures. It may be noted that all the **signatures must be in full** (not in short) and signatures done on the printout of the application form and other documents must be the same.
- iii. The photograph and signature pasted/uploaded in the application form are blurred, distorted, or not clear.
- iv. Non-Payment of Examination Fees or non-receipt of fees through online mode, if not otherwise exempted.
- v. The fee was not paid as per instructions.
- vi. Failure to bring (in original) all relevant certificates/Documents issued by the competent authority, along with self-attested legible copies in support of the information given in their Application forms about their Educational Qualifications; Experiences; Percentage of marks obtained; proof of age; proof of category (SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWBD) and their print out of application form at the time of verification of documents.
- vii. Not having the requisite Educational Qualification/Category Status on the requisite date as mentioned in the Prospectus.
- viii. Incorrect Information or misrepresentation or suppression of material facts.
- ix. For carrying mobile phones/ accessories in the examination premises/hall.
- x. Any other irregularity.

26. Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct:

- A. Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information while filling in the application form. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case attempt to alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or the attested certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document. If there is any inaccuracy or any discrepancy, an explanation regarding this discrepancy should be submitted.
- B. Without prejudice to criminal action/debarment up to 3 years from the examination conducted by AIIMS Patna wherever necessary, the candidature will be summarily cancelled at any stage of the admission on respect of candidates found to have indulged in any of the following activities.
 - a. In the procession of mobile phones and/or accessories and other electronic gadgets within the premises of the examination centre at AIIMS Patna, whether in use or in switched-off mode and on a person or otherwise.
 - b. Involved in malpractices.
 - c. Using unfair means in the examination hall.
 - d. Obtaining support for his/her candidature by any means.
 - e. Impersonate/procure impersonation by the person.
 - f. Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with.
 - g. Making statements that are incorrect or false or suppressing material information.
 - h. Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination.
 - i. Misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall with the supervisor, invigilator, or supporting staff of AIIMS Patna.
 - j. Intimidating or causing bodily harm to the staff employed by AIIMS Patna for the conduct of the examination.

27. Legal and Disciplinary Action

Legal and disciplinary action will be initiated by AIIMS Patna against persons who are found to be guilty of misconduct for reasons mentioned below (including but not limited to):

- 1. Obtaining support for his/her candidature by the following means, namely: offering illegal gratification to; or applying pressure on; or blackmailing, or threatening to blackmail any person connected with the conduct of the examination; or
- 2. Impersonation; or
- 3. Procuring impersonation by any person; or
- 4. Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with; or
- 5. Providing false information regarding educational qualifications and/or experience (such as internship completion) for the sole purpose of appearing in the examination for practice or any other purposes; or
- 6. Uploading irrelevant photos in the application form in place of actual photo/signature/; or

- 7. Uploading morphed/digitally modified photos for the purpose of impersonation; or
- 8. Making statements that are incorrect or false or suppressing material information; or
- 9. Resorting to the following means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination, namely: obtaining questions through improper means; finding out the particulars of the persons connected with secret work relating to the examination; influencing the personnel involved with the conduct of the examination.
- 10. Being in possession of or using unfair means during the examination;
- 11. Copying the questions, misbehaving in the examination hall including tearing of the scripts, provoking fellow examinees to boycott examination, creating a disorderly scene, and the like; or
- 12. Harassing or doing bodily harm to the staff deputed by the Examination Section, Staff employed by Vendors for the purpose of conducting of examination.
- 13. Being in possession of or using any mobile phone, (even in switched off mode), pager or any electronic equipment or programmable device or storage media like pen drive, smart watches, etc. or camera or Bluetooth devices or any other equipment or related accessories either in working or switched off mode capable of being used as a communication device during the examination; or
- 14. Violating any of the instructions issued to candidates along with their admission certificates permitting them to take the examination; or
- 15. Attempting to commit or, as the case may be, abetting the commission of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clauses; may in addition to rendering himself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:
 - a) Shall be disqualified by the AIIMS Patna from this/or other Examinations for which he/she is a candidate; and/or
 - b) Shall be liable to be debarred either permanently or for a specified period:
 - i. By the Examination Section, AIIMS Patna, from any examination or selection held by them; or
 - ii. Any other penalty as per the discretion of the competent authority or
 - c) If he/she is already in service under Government to disciplinary action under the appropriate rules.

Provided that no penalty under this section shall be imposed except after:

- I. Giving the candidate an opportunity of making such representation in writing as he/she may wish to make on that behalf; and
- II. Taking the representation, if any, submitted by the candidate within the period allowed to him into consideration.

28. Other Important Points

- **b.** Any amendment/ Rectification/Change/Editing is not allowed in Name, Category, Department, and PwBD status once submitted. Any change in address, mobile no, and email ID should be intimated to this office immediately.
- c. The competent authority reserves the right to any amendment, cancellation, and changes to this advertisement as a whole or in part without assigning any reason or giving notice.
- d. In case, any information given or declaration by the candidate is found to be false or if the candidate has willfully suppressed any material information relevant to his/her admission, he/she will be liable to be removed from the institute and any action taken as deemed fit by the competent authority.

- k. The selected candidates will have to submit the original Permanent Registration Certificate at the time of reporting.
- **l.** The selection of a post-doctoral fellowship (PDF) candidate will be subject to medical fitness. No selected candidate will be permitted to pay the course fee/ join the course unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the institute.

 The decision of the Medical Board shall be final.
- **m.** Private practice in any form during the course is prohibited. The period of training is strictly full-time and continuous.
- n. The rules are subject to change in accordance with the decision of the institute to be taken from time to time.
- o. Candidates are not allowed to bring mobile phones, books, notes, loose sheets, any other electronic gadgets, or any other communication device inside the examination premises/hall and any infringement of these instructions will entail debarment from the future examination of AIIMS Patna without prejudice to initiation of criminal proceedings against the candidates.
